The two reputed Institutes of the city, the Indian Institute of Information Technology, Nagpur (IIITN), and the Central India Institute of Medical Sciences (CIIMS), Nagpur, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Wednesday, 5th January, 2022. The signing of the MOU took place in the august presence of the Directors, Dr. Rajpal Singh Kashyap (Director, Research, CIIMS) and Prof. O. G. Kakde (IIITN). The occasion was also witnessed by the Incharge Dean, Dr. Ashwin Kothari, Registrar, Mr. Kailas Dakhale from IIITN, and the renowned neurologist Dr. Neeraj Baheti from CIIMS.

The MOU aims to take up joint research on computational and electronic integration in health care domain.
