- i) Candidate should possess minimum MBBS Degree. Preference shall be given to the candidate having post-graduation i.e. MD Degree.
- ii) Candidate having experience in providing Medical Services in Educational Institutions / Hospitals or other Establishments.

- 1. The above position is purely on temporary and contractual basis for a period of **One Year** with provision for subsequent extensions as per Institute Policy subject to performance.
