

The BoG inquired about the justification for higher Bench Mark of 15% IRR for assessing the Feasibility of the Project. The Transaction Adviser explained that in normal case the Benchmark Project IRR is 15% for most projects and can vary as per project requirements and risk. The cost of debt is to the tune of 11% (SBI MCLR + 2-2.5% spread) and hence cost of equity would be 15-16% considering the risk premium. This translates into WACC of 12 – 13%.			



The Project IRR benchmark is kept at 15% because, though it may see that the concessionaire would have assured clientele (i.e. students) and fee assurance, but the risk likes in intermittent dip as perceived by the bidder considering future competition over long period of 22 years. If there is high competition, Project IRR expectation of bidder may go down to 14-14.5% also; but if we keep benchmark of 14% then the competition would try to push them below 14% which may not be feasible for them and hence end up without bidding. Keeping lower benchmark would tend to reduce competition. Hence, keeping benchmark of 15% IRR for Project is more appropriate. Further, the BoG noted that subsequent to circulation of the documents to the Members, on 16-10-2023 the Transaction Adviser has suggested certain changes in the eligibility criteria to facilitate higher participation in the proposed Bidding process. The Transaction Adviser also suggested that the Quality & Cost Based System (QCBS) to be adopted for technical scrutiny be made part of the RFP Document itself for information of all the prospective bidders. The BoG approved the proposed QCBS System to be adopted for technical scrutiny and also approved the proposal with following documents for further needful action by the Institute: Project Feasibility Report (PFR) Request for Proposal (RFP) i.e. the Tender Document Concession Agreement To approve the initial drawings submitted by CPWD for the Academic BoG7.04.03 Block - B.
