NOTIFICATION FOR ENGAGEMENT OF GRADUATE / TECHNICIAN APPRENTICES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2026-27 UNDER THE APPRENTICESHIP ACT, 1961 (AMENDED TILL DATE)

Indian Institute of Information Technology, Nagpur (IIITN) is one of the 20 Indian Institutes of Information Technology established under Public-Private Partnership Scheme by Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India. IIITN has been declared as an “**Institution of National Importance**” under the provisions of Indian Institute of Information Technology (Public-Private Partnership) Act, 2017. The Institute is presently functioning under Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education and is supported by Department of Higher Education, Government of Maharashtra and Tata Consultancy Services, Mumbai and Haldiram Foods International Pvt. Ltd., Nagpur as Industry Partners.

IIIT, Nagpur is offering Under Graduate and PhD Programmes in Computer Science & Engineering (CSE) and Electronics & Communication Engineering (ECE) Courses. Further, from the Academic Year 2022-23 onwards the Institute has started four new Undergraduate Courses in the areas of Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning, Data Science & Analytics, Human Computer Interaction & Gaming Technology and Internet of Things.

The Institute is located at a distance of about 25 Kms from the Nagpur City at Survey No. 140,141/1, Behind Br. Sheshrao Wankhade Shetkari Sahakari Soot Girni, Village - Waranga, PO - Dongargaon (Butibori), District - Nagpur – 441108 (Maharashtra). The development of state-of-the-art Permanent Campus of the Institute is being undertaken on sprawling 100 Acres of land.

The Institute invites applications from eligible Graduate / Diploma Holders for undergoing One Year Apprenticeship Training under the Apprenticeship Act, 1961 (Amended till date). This training will be governed by Board of Apprenticeship Training (Western Region), Mumbai.

A. Graduate Apprentices Trainees:

Disciplines: -

- 1. Library Science Graduate (1 No):** A Master Degree in Library Science / Bachelor of Library & Information Science (B. Lib) granted by a Statutory University recognized by the State Government OR Central Government.
- 2. General Stream Graduates (BA / B. Sc / B. Com)- (13 Nos):** A Degree in Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Commerce & Bachelor of Arts granted by a Statutory University recognized by the State Government OR Central Government.
- 3. Graduate (AI Apprentice)- (1 No):** A Degree in BE / B. Tech in Computer Science & Engineering, Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning, Data Science & Analytics, Human Computer Interaction & Gaming Technology or related branches granted by a Statutory University recognized by the State Government OR Central Government.

B. Technician Apprentices Trainees:

- 1. Civil Engineering & Electrical Engineering (1 Civil & 1 Electrical):** A Diploma in Engineering or Technology in relevant discipline granted by a State Council or Board of Technical Education established by a State Government OR Central Government. BE/BTech candidates can also apply, however the engagement rules will be applicable as per BOAT guidelines.

C. General Terms & Conditions:

1. The interested candidates are requested to note that the **Walk-In-Interviews** shall be conducted offline at the Permanent Campus located at IIIT Nagpur, S.No. 140, 141/1, Behind Br. Sheshrao Wankhade Shetkari Sahkari Soot Girni, Village-Waranga, PO-Dongargaon (Butibori), Dist-Nagpur (MS)
2. **Date of Walk-In -Interview: 12th March, 2026 (Thursday) (From 10.30 AM to 2 PM).** The candidate who wishes to appear for Walk-In-Interview must report at the Institute at 9.30 AM.
3. **The candidates who appeared for interview on 24th & 25th February, 2026, need not to appear again for Walk -In-Interview. The selection will be done on the basis of merit.**
4. The candidate will have to download the Prescribed Application Form enclosed with the Advertisement duly filled and bring on the date of Walk-In-Interview along with all the original relevant documents with one set of self-attested photocopy.
5. **Stipend of Rs. 9000/- (Rs. 12,300/- under revision) per month will be paid to Graduate Apprentice Trainees and Rs. 8000/- (Rs. 10,900/- under revision) per month will be paid to Technician Apprentice Trainees. 50% stipend will be paid by the Board of Apprenticeship Training (BOAT) and 50% will be borne by the IIIT, Nagpur. (Reference OM No. DGT-36/1/2021-AP (Computer No. E-38255) Dt. 15-09-2025, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, (Apprentice Training Division), Government of India).**

6. Candidate passed their final qualifying semester of Degree / Diploma Course in above mentioned disciplines recognized by Statutory University/ AICTE /GOI **on or after 01 April 2021** is eligible.
7. Those candidates having qualifications equivalent to any of the prescribed qualifications should submit Equivalency Certificate issued by the Competent Authority and without such certificate, their candidature will not be considered.
8. Age limit will be followed as per Apprenticeship Rules. Only Indian nationals need apply.
9. Apprentices Act Guidelines on reservation applicable for SC, ST, OBC-NCL, EWS & PWD will be strictly followed.
- 10. The duration of Apprenticeship training will be for a period of One year. The training will start from 1st April -2026.**
11. Candidates who have already undergone or are currently undergoing apprenticeship under Apprenticeship Act 1961 (Amended till Date) in any Government or Public Sector or Private industrial organization are not eligible.
- 12. Upon completion of the Apprenticeship Period, the Institute shall have no obligation to offer employment to such apprentices nor can an apprentice claim right for employment in the Institute on the grounds of completion of Apprenticeship.**
13. Every candidate should have a valid email Id & Mobile number. The email id & mobile no. must remain active until the end of the training programme in respect of the selected candidates. The Institute will not be responsible for any loss of e-mail sent due to invalid / wrong E-mail ID provided by the candidate or delivery of e-mails to SPAM / BULK mail folder etc.
14. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS shall produce their Caste/Category Certificate (Current Year) in the prescribed format issued by the Competent Authority applicable for jobs under Government of India, during Walk-In-Interview.
15. Candidates have to produce their valid ID card, i.e., AADHAR / PAN / Voters ID / Driving License / Certificate Issued by Educational Institute, during personal interaction.
16. The eligible candidates are required to mention the 'Total Marks and Marks obtained in the qualifying exam throughout the semesters in 3/4 Years Degree / 3 Years Diploma'. In case semester results are declared in Grade Point Average then 'Total Marks and Marks Obtained shall be converted and provided as per norms of the Institute / University'.
17. No TA / DA will be paid to the candidates for Walk-In-Interview.
18. The decision of the Director, IITN will be final and binding on the candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, mode of selection, cancellation of the selection process (either in part or full) etc.
19. The decision about filling up of the vacancies is solely at the discretion of the Director, IITN based on suitability of candidates and no claim will arise for engagement if some of the vacancies are not filled for any reason.

20. The candidature of the candidates would be provisional and subject to subsequent verification of certificates / testimonial, at any stage of the selection process, if it is found that the candidate has furnished false or incorrect information then the candidature / engagement of the candidate is liable to be cancelled.
21. In case of any dispute regarding the Apprentices Engagement Process, the place of jurisdiction shall be Nagpur, Maharashtra (India) only.
22. Selected candidates have to register themselves on NATS 2.0 portal (Student Register) before joining the Institute.
