	Agenda: As per the approval from 5thBoG, the recruitment process for teaching staff was initiated for Assistant Professor Grade-II Level-10 Rs. 70,900/- (Basic) in various departments such as Electronics and Communication Engineering, Computer Science and Engineering, Basic Sciences and Engineering (Mathematics), and Basic Sciences and Engineering (Humanities) through the advertisement for Recruitment which was published on website of IIIT, Nagpur, sent Recruitment Advertisement to CFTI's and All India Edition news papers, vide Recruitment Notice No IIITN /R/Teaching/2018/01 dated 30.11.2018 with last date of submission of application as January 9, 2019. The same was put up on website of IIIT, Nagpur and was also sent to CFTI's for giving wide publicity. The selection process was completed in two phases from 25.03.3019 to 30.03.2019 and selected 17 Nos. of faculty members.
	The Director's Report on appointments of the Teaching Staff is enclosed as Annexure-VI.
Resolution	During discussions, the BoG opined that in addition to the Faculty-Student Ratio, Accreditation Requirement etc, the Institute needs to consider Financial Outlay also while implementing the Recruitment Plan.
	After deliberation, the BoG approved the recommendations of the Selection Committee of Faculty Members and allowed Director IIIT, Nagpur to issue the appointment orders.
6.06	Sanction of additional 17 faculty positions to be filled in phased manner.
	Agenda: As the Institute is in its fourth year of operation and strength of the student will be 575. The total no. of faculty required is 48 (575/12=48). 31 positions are already sanctioned; hence BoG is requested to sanction 17 (48-31=17) faculty positions which will be recruited in phase manner as per requirement.

Resolution

In accordance with the deliberations had in the context of Agenda Item No. 6.05, the BoG opined that existing 8 and additional 17 would take the strength to 25 faculties. Also, 6 sanctioned positions would be further available.

Accordingly, the BoG decided to defer the proposal at this stage and directed IIIT, Nagpur to approach BoG as and when required for approval of additional Teaching Staff positions considering the actual strength of the students.

Approval of BoG is therefore requested to initiate the recruitment process for Non-Teaching Staff (24 Nos). The detailed list of requirements of non-teaching staff is enclosed as **Annexure-VII**.

It is also requested to approve one time age relaxation to those employees who have been working on adhoc/temporary/contract basis in IIIT, Nagpur, so that they can participate in the recruitment process subject to full filling of other eligibility criteria.

Agenda: In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act 2019 and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM no. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019, enabling provision of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Schedule Casts, the Schedule Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, it has been decided to provide reservations in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten percent of the total seats in each category.

In addition to this decision was taken in Co-ordination Forum Meeting vide item no. 1.06 in connection with admission by IIIT's (PPP) for addition of 10% supernumerary seats by IIIIT's (PPP) (in their seat matrix) to compensate for the seat lying vacant.
